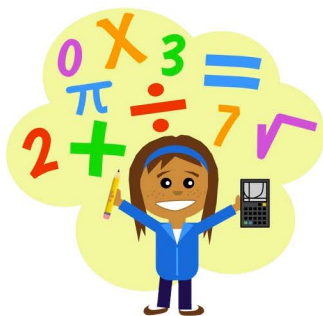


Figure it Out!

President Franklin Delano Roosevelt's first term in office started in **1932**. Each term as president lasts four years. He served **12** years in office.

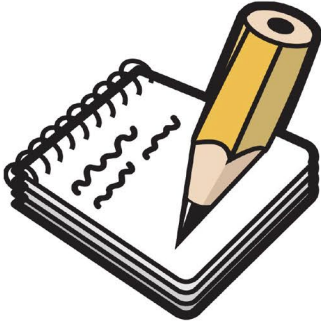

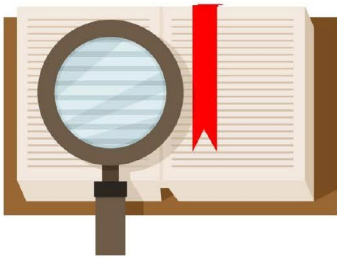
